IV. BUDGET

CRC budget implementation for 2015

Commission for Regulation of Communications is a primary administrator of budget.

By the Law on State Budget of the Republic of Bulgaria for 2015 the Ministry of Finance has determined for the CRC:

- Revenue amounting to BGN 81 500 thousand.
- Expenses amounted to BGN 7 596 thousand.

The Commission administers revenue pursuant to Art. 51, para. 1, of the LEC and Art. 62 of the PSA.

In 2015, the receipts to the Commission's budget totalled BGN 64 191 thousand from fees, penalty notices and interest, which represents a 79% fulfilment. The fees with relatively permanent nature concerning the permits issued for use of individually assigned scarce resource were reached BGN 43,000 thousand. The remaining BGN 38 500 thousand are intended as income from one-time fees and are not fulfilled, regardless of taken measures by the Commission. In 2015, CRC on two occasions announced its plans to hold a tender for issuance of permits for use of radio frequency spectrum in 2500-2690 MHz radio frequency band with the Decisions No. 411 of 31.08.2015, and No. 477 from 08.10.2015, as in specified deadlines there were no intentions submitted by the undertakings.

As a good practice in regard to revenue collectability can be mentioned that the commission annually reminds the undertakings for the opportunity to use 5 percentile discount for payment of annual fees for use of individually assigned scarce resource - numbers, radio frequency spectrum and/or positions of geostationary orbit allocated to Republic of Bulgaria under international agreements, until March 31 of the relevant year in accordance with Art. 13, para. 2, of the Tariff of fees collected by the CRC under the LEC, by:

- publishing a communication on the website of the CRC and
- sending of automatically generated individual e-mail messages.

As a result, in 2015 95% of the revenue from that type of fees has been collected as early as in the first quarter of the year, and the trend is durable and ascending and more undertakings take advantage of the opportunity provided.

In connection with Art. 163, para. 1 of the Tax-Insurance Procedure Code and Art. 337 of the LEC, in non-payment of public debts and infringement CRC has issued acts for establishing public receivables and penalty notices.
